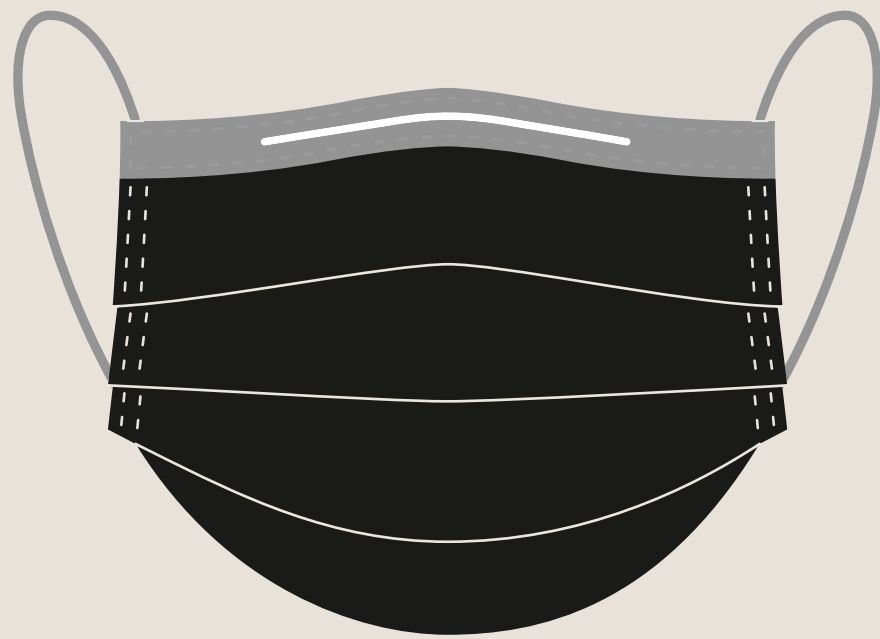

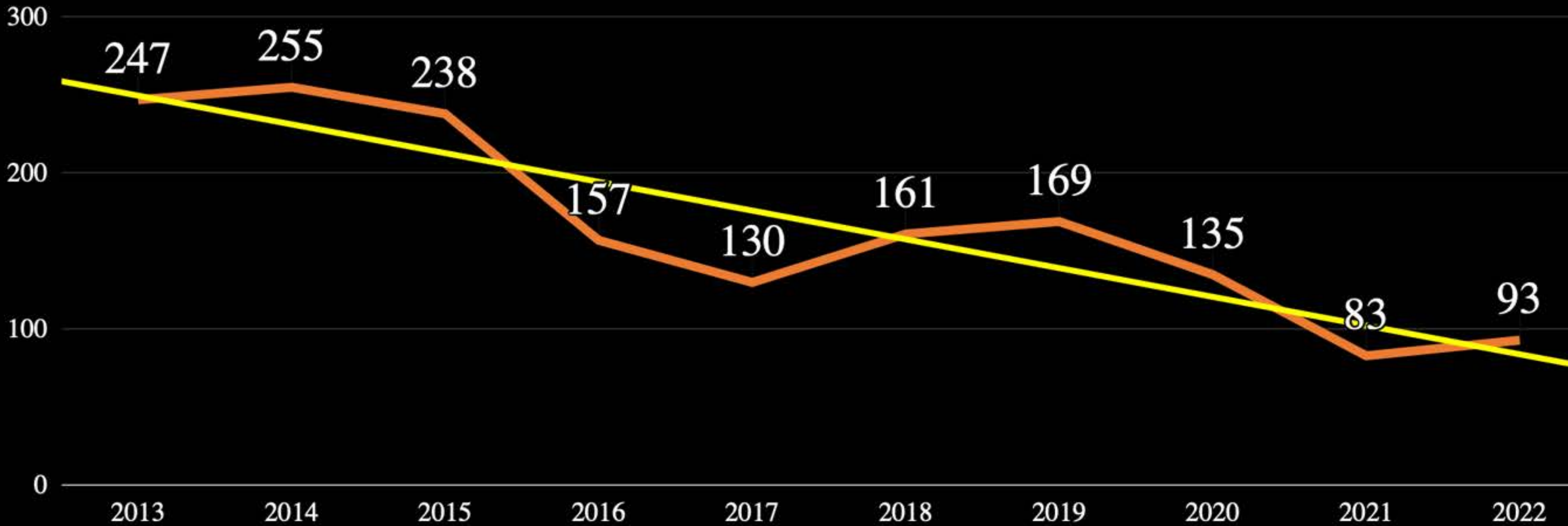

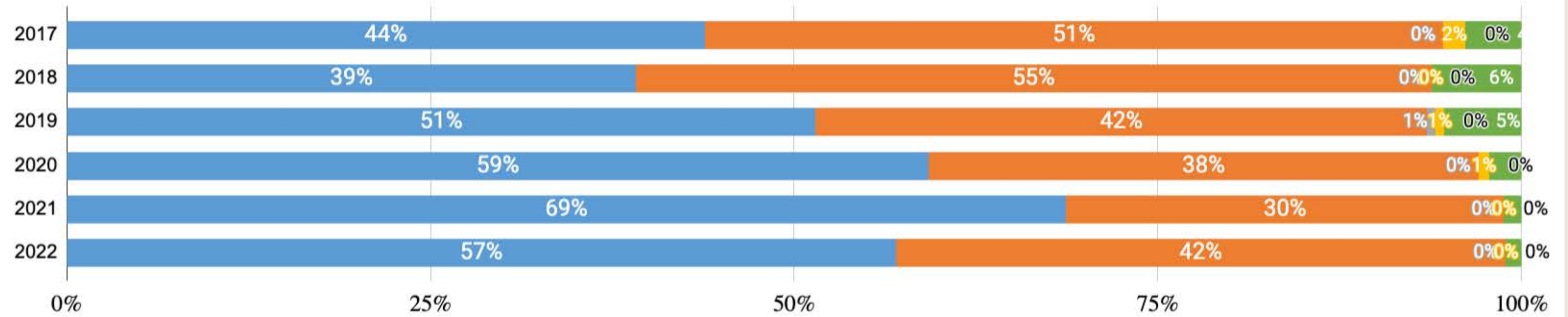

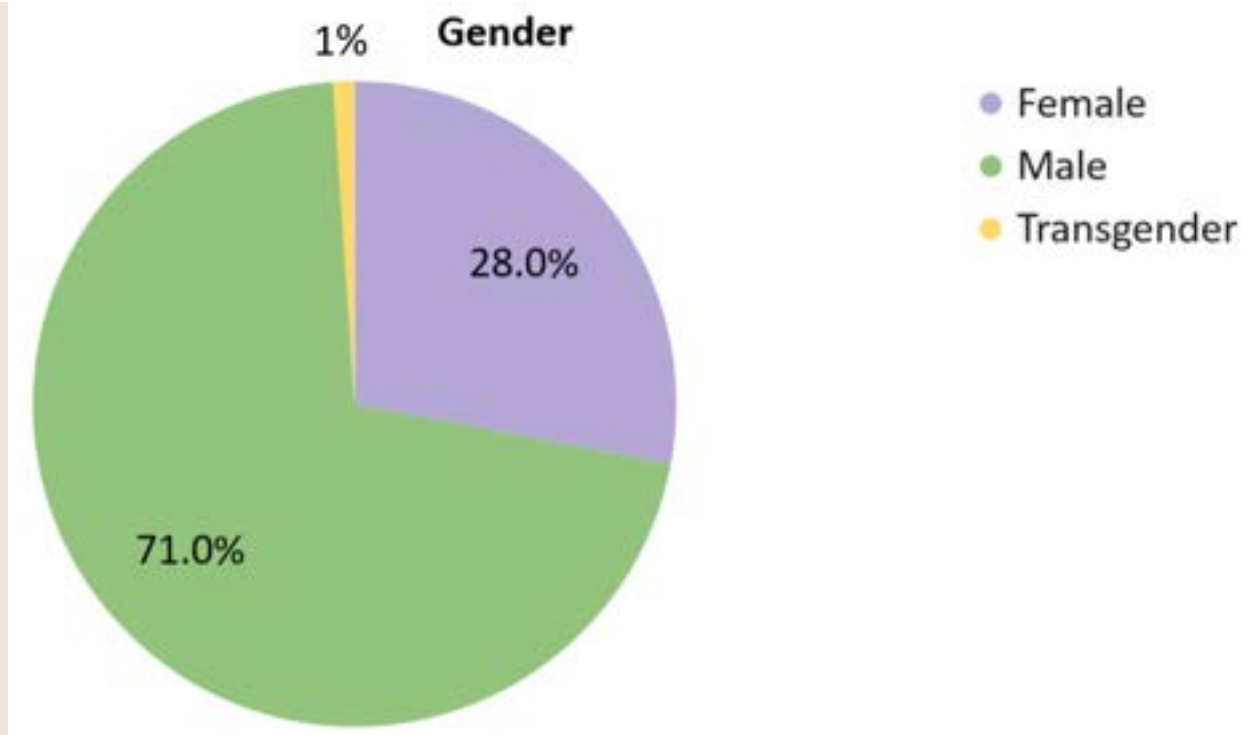
Individuals Who Experience Homelessness Macon County



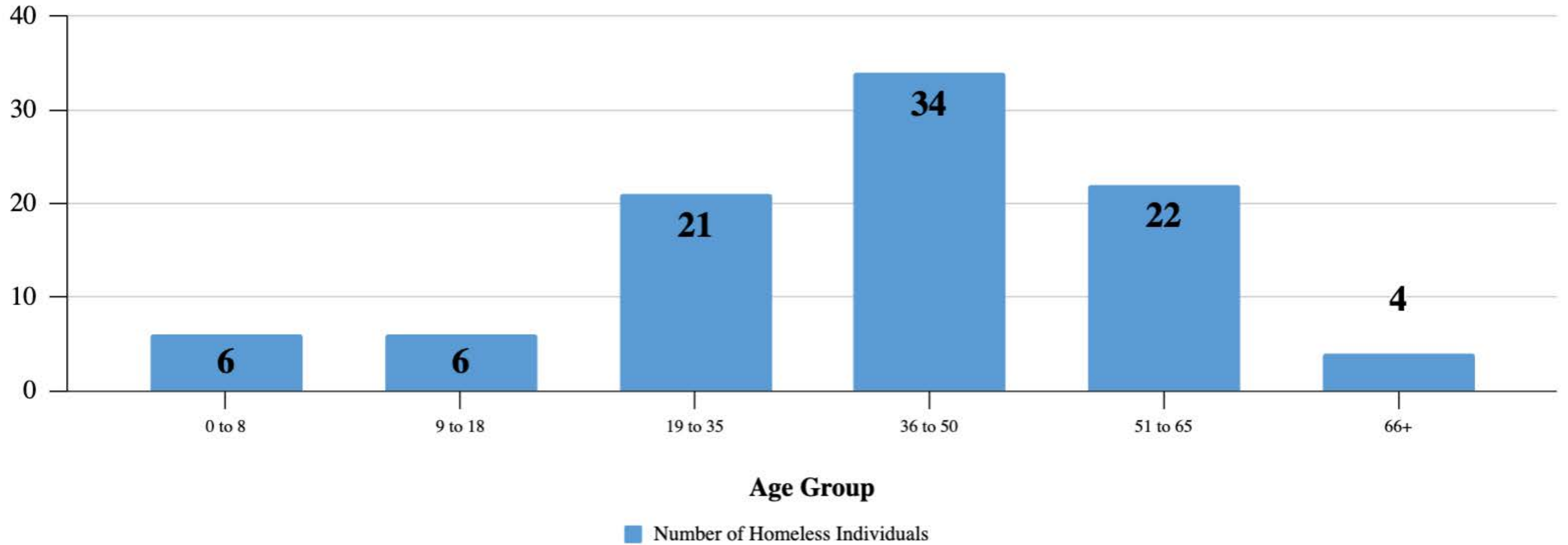
Percentage of Race by Year



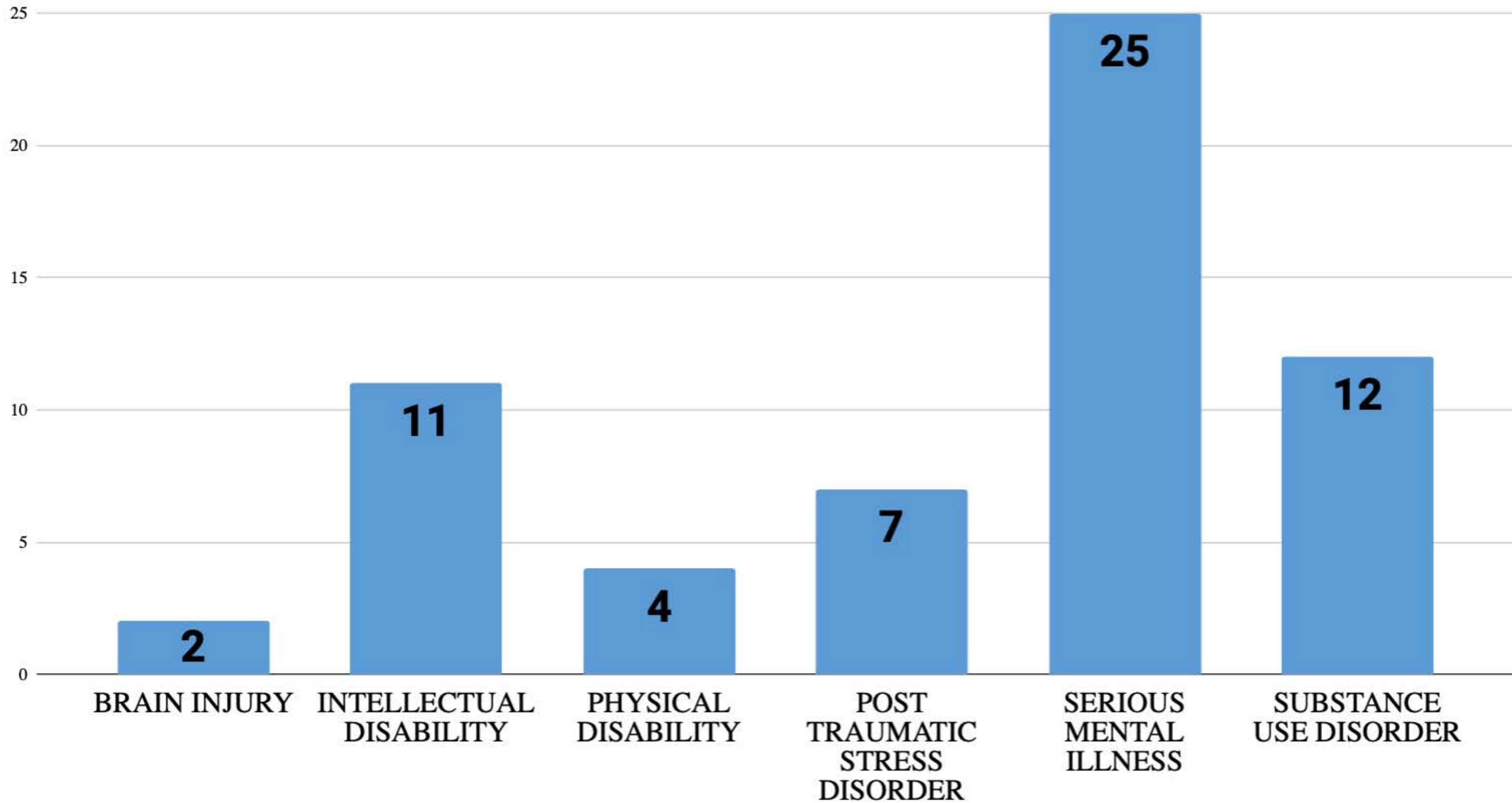

Individuals Who Experience Homelessness By Age Group

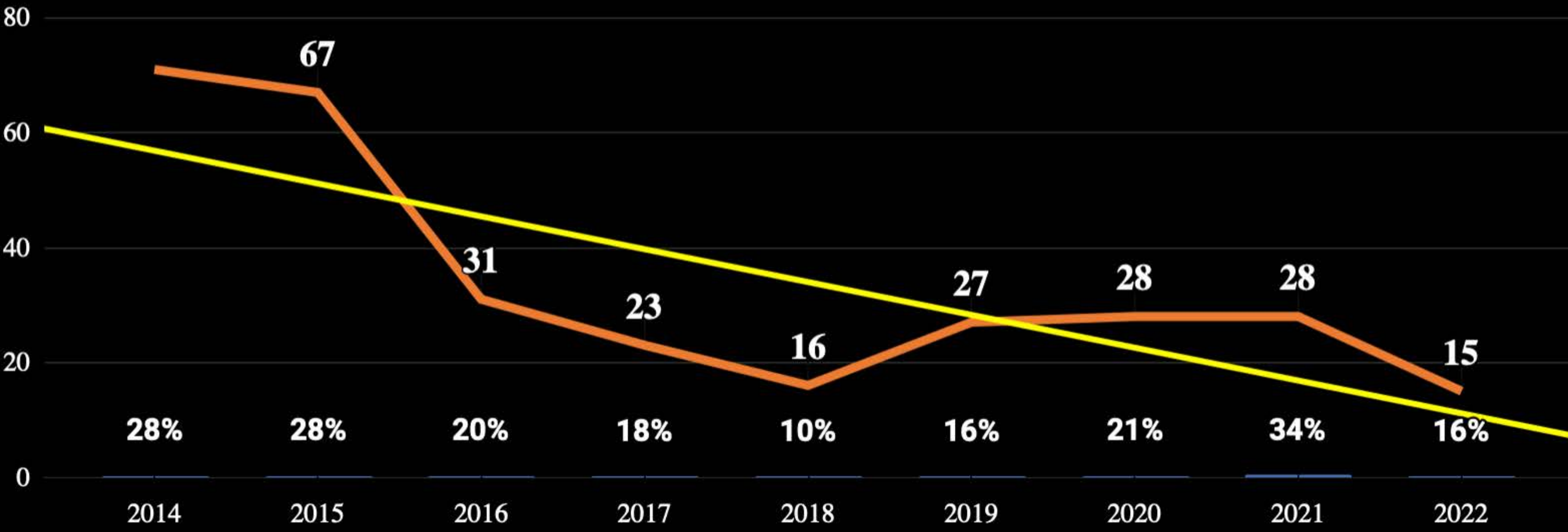

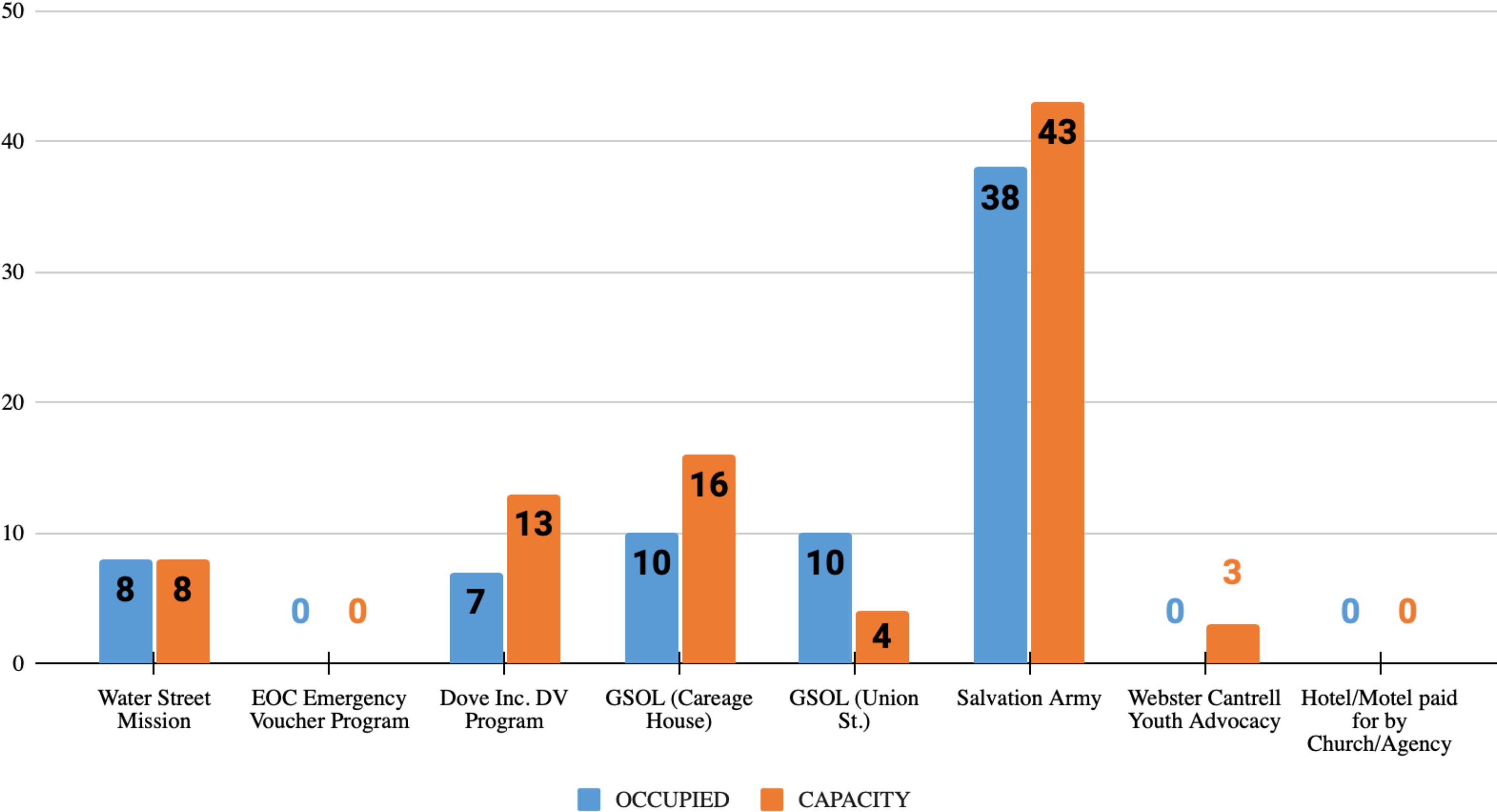


Individuals Who Experience Chronic Homelessness in Macon County

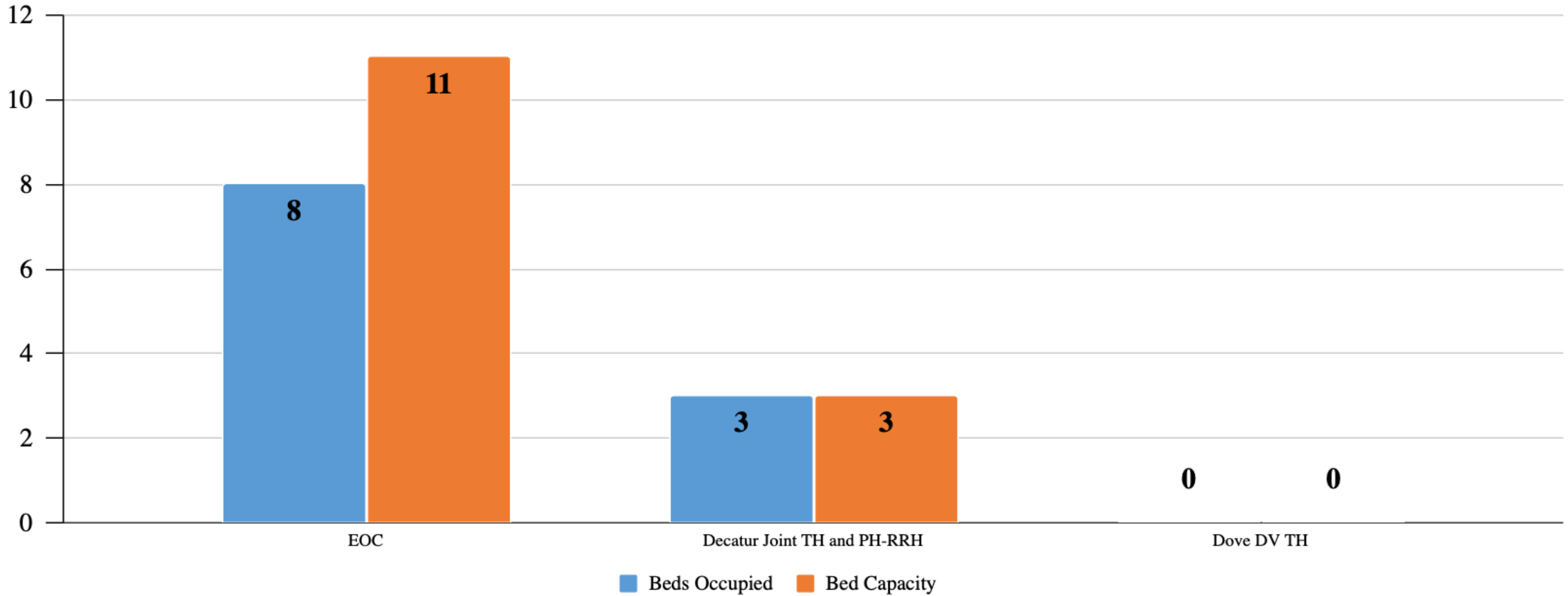
Chronic: Total number of persons Linear (Chronic: Total number of persons) Chronic Homeless Percentage



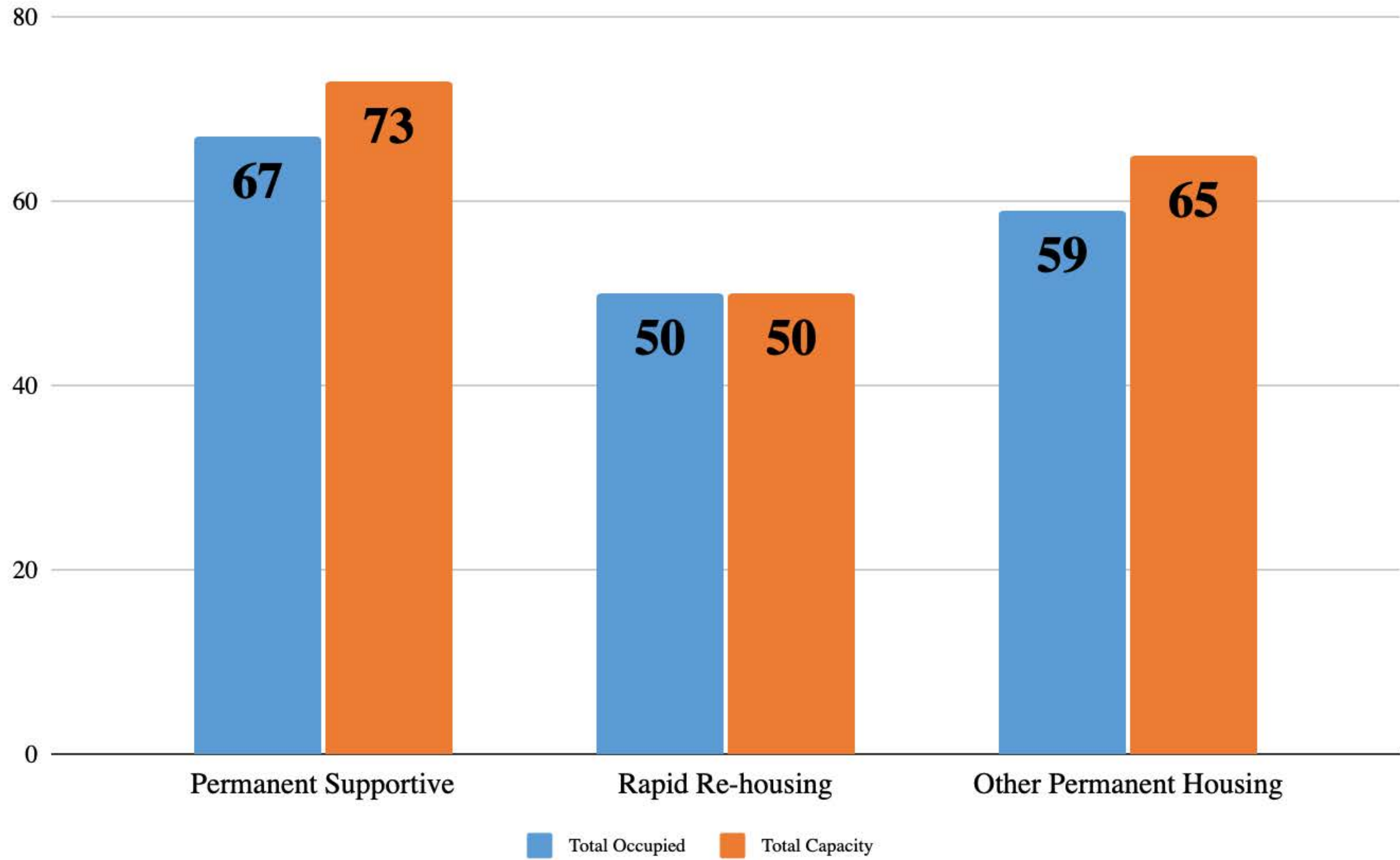
Emergency Shelter



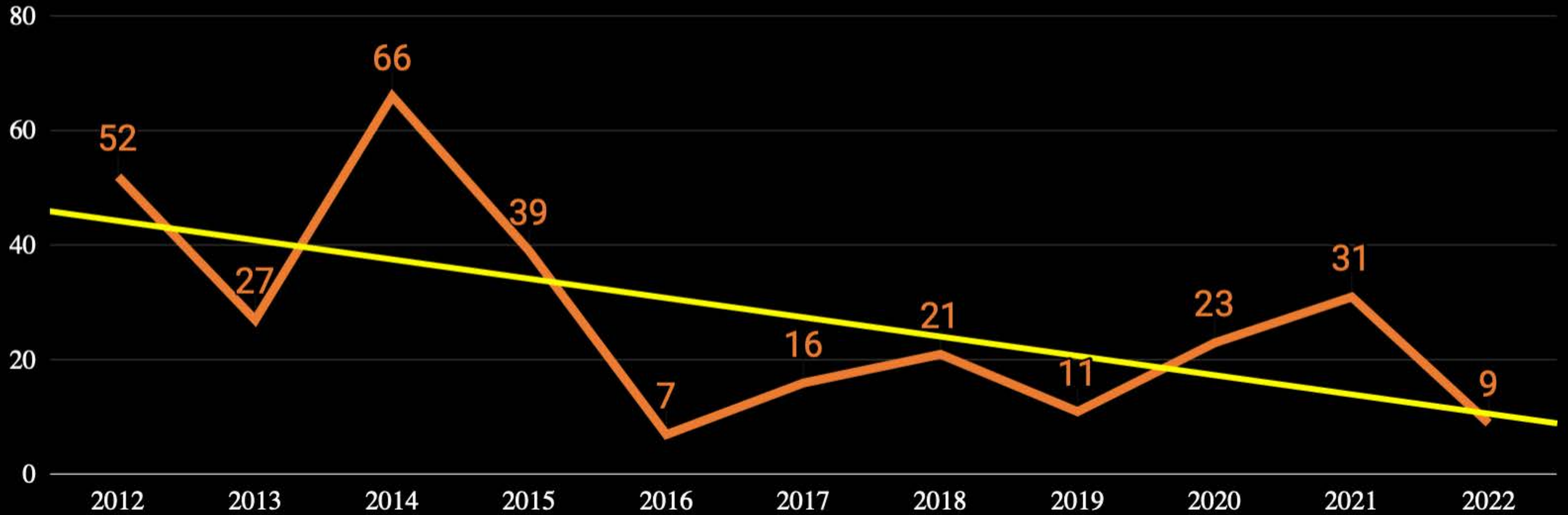
HIC Bed Capacity: Transitional Housing
